One-minute Meditation (Begin with a prayer)

The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. – John 10:10

A little girl had reached the place in school where she was being introduced to the wonders of arithmetic. Multiplication signs, minus signs, division signs, and plus signs – all made a deep impression on her. One day, as she was sitting in church with her parents, who were members of one of today’s popular denominations, she noticed a large gold cross on the altar. Turning to her father, she whispered, “Daddy, what is the plus sign doing on the altar?”

The little girl was a bit confused over the difference between a cross and a plus sign; nevertheless the cross is without question the greatest plus sign on the universe! Because of the cross we not only have life, we have it “more abundantly.” “To the death of Christ we owe even this earthly life. The bread we eat is the purchase of His broken body. The water we drink is bought by His spilled blood. Never one, saint or sinner, eats his daily food, but he is nourished by the body and the blood of Christ. The cross of Calvary is stamped on every loaf. It is reflected in every water spring.” - *The Desire of Ages*, p. 660

The little girl who was being initiated to the wonders of arithmetic saw plus signs everywhere because her mind was occupied with this mathematical symbol. A person who looks directly at the sun, even for a moment, sees the outline of the sun on every object on which he gazes for the next few minutes. Thus, also, the Christian who spends sufficient time contemplating the cross will see its image reflected everywhere. And that image will add a new dimension to life. Work will be a pleasure because it is service for the King. Obedience will bring joy because we love the One who said, “Keep my commandments.” Sacrifice and self-denial will bring blessings because they enable us to share heaven’s gifts with others.
