One-minute Meditation (Begin with a prayer)

“His Lord said unto him, ‘Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou has been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of the Lord.’ ” - Matthew 25:21

In the parable of the Talents, the servant who had received five talents worked honestly and diligently, and by the time his master returned from his far journey he had doubled the money entrusted to him. Likewise, the servant who had received two talents invested wisely and gained two other talents. To both of these servants the master said, “Well done.”

But the servant who had received only one talent buried it. He did not put it to use. He did not improve it. As a result, when his master returned, this slothful servant received a severe rebuke. Moreover, the one talent which he had been entrusted was removed, and he was cast “into outer darkness.”

The tragedy of this parable is not that the servant was punished, but that his talent was not put to use. Because of his unfaithfulness, souls were deprived of aid and blessing.

All his life Luigi Tarisio collected violins as a hobby. No one knew how many he had; but when he died, 246 exquisite instruments were found crammed into his attic. In the bottom drawer of a rickety old dresser was a genuine Stradivarius nearly 150 years old. There it lay in speechless silence, waiting for the touch of the master’s hand.

Luigi had a right to love priceless violins, but he had no right to “bury” them and thus withhold from the world music that could have thrilled the spirit and inspired the soul.

Well has the messenger of the Lord written: “The talents, however few, are to be put to use. The question that most concerns us is not, How much have I received? But, What am I doing with that which I have? The development of all our powers is the first duty we owe to God and to our fellow men.”-*Christ Object Lessons, p. 329*
